4.10.1 Elizabeth Bradford ("Hat"), first child of Hardie Bradford and Lottie Morgan Bradford, was born on 6 May 1903 in Uniontown, Alabama. She graduated from Judson College in Marion, Alabama.

She was married on 5 June 1930 in Uniontown to William Adams Kimbrough, born on 11 January 1900 in Thomasville, Alabama (son of Julius Wood Kimbrough and Coral Adams Kimbrough). He graduated from the University of Alabama and owned and managed the J. W. Kimbrough General Store in Thomasville, where they lived. The store was in continuous operation from 1893, when his father founded it, until the death of W. A. Kimbrough in 1966.
