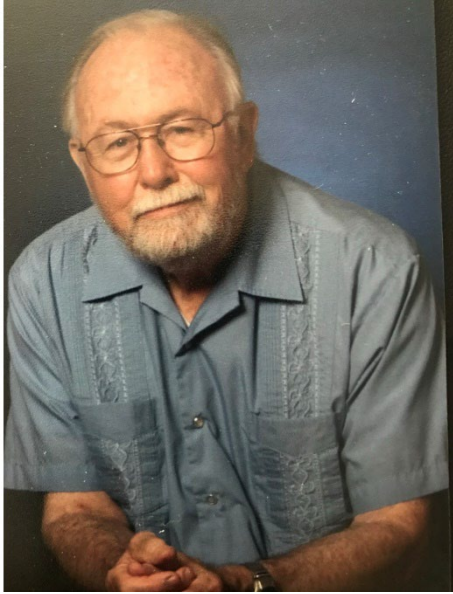


Richard Morgan Griffiths (1936 – 2021) - m.1.6.2.3

Dick Griffiths was born 10 September 1936 in Gosport, New York and died at home on 12 June 2021 in Grants Pass, Oregon. Dick married Robin Hardie (1.6.2.3) in 1960. He attended the University of Rhode Island where he earned a B.S. in Electrical Engineering. Dick served in Japan with the U.S. Air Force and worked for North American Aviation in Downey, California where among other things he designed antennas for NASA's Apollo Lunar missions. He later joined the U.S. Department of State Foreign Service, where his 20 plus years in counterintelligence and counterterrorism spanned 7 continents and more than 100 countries. Dick and his family were posted in Frankfurt, Germany; Abidjan, Ivory Coast; Manila, Philippines; Hong Kong, BCC; Panama; Rio de Janeiro, Brazil; Moscow, Soviet Union; Nairobi, Kenya; and Washington, DC. He and Robin retired to Lake Tahoe, Nevada, then Grants Pass, Oregon. His many pleasures included boating, camping, fishing, cross-country skiing, travel, and reading.
